




I Love Math – Lesson 10: Improper Fractions to Mixed Numbers




Discussion

Improper fractions can be written as mixed numbers. A mixed number shows how many whole parts there are and what fraction remains. For example, $5/4$ means one whole ($4/4$) and $1/4$ left over.

Examples (Answers shown for learning)

	$5/4 = 1 \frac{1}{4}$
	$6/4 = 1 \frac{2}{4}$ (or $1 \frac{1}{2}$)
	$7/4 = 1 \frac{3}{4}$
